Import Check List

Before you go,

- Contact Vantage Point Services (Shannon Montoya, Operations Manager 1-206-878-8884) shannon@vantagept.com
- Have your power of attorney & forms completed and returned to Shannon Montoya at VPS
- Register Your gun with US Customs and Border Protection
- Check with airline and Location where you intend to hunt to verify firearm regulations
- Tell Shannon Montoya at Vantage Point Services the name of your Taxidermist in the U.S.

While abroad,

- Obtain a copy of your hunt register
- Obtain full contact details for taxidermist or dip & pack company
- Provide Vantage Point Services information to the PH and foreign taxidermist.
- Provide Preferred port of entry where trophies are to be shipped (Seattle, WA)

(Montana Rocky Mountain Fur Dressers, Inc. recommends the port of Seattle, WA to save on shipping cost)

Once you return contact VANTAGE POINT SERVICES.

- Advise of contact details for foreign taxidermist or dip and pack company
- Advise of any curios expected
- Provide a copy of the hunt register or a listing of animals taken
- Request that all export documents be sent to you and Vantage Point Services
- If CITES I or ESA species is taken, apply for U.S. Import Permit from US FWS
- Review documents closely for errors or omissions
- Request quotations with insurance prior to approving export to U.S.
- If ocean transportation, ensure all ISF data is complete



Once Trophies arrive in Seattle (SEA), Vantage Point Services will handle all papers and permits to clear the trophies. Vantage Point Services will separately invoice for the clearance and delivery and is due upon receipt.

Upon clearance the trophies will be shipped to Montana Rocky Mountain Fur Dresser, Inc. facility. The taxidermist of your choice will be billed for the processing and tanning of their hunter's safari, unless other arrangements are made. All communications will be directly between Montana Rocky Mountain Fur Dressers, Inc. and the taxidermist. The taxidermist is then responsible for communications to the hunter(s) regarding their safari. It is our goal to make this service as simple as possible.
